Shortlisting of Candidates for Document Verification (DV)

1.0 The list of Roll numbers of Candidates provisionally Shortlisted for DV have been published as a PDF document on RRB Websites. The Roll Numbers are arranged horizontally in ascending order and not in order of merit. The published list of shortlisted candidates for DV includes 50% additional candidates (subject to availability of eligible candidates) for the posts over and above the revised vacancies published on the websites of RRBs.

Additional candidates are called for DV to make good the shortfall arising out of various attritions during DV, Medical and after furnishing of panel to railways. Hence, the cut off for DV is not published as the category wise cut off will undergo complete change after DV. <u>Accordingly, the Category number wise and reservation category wise cut off will be published only after the final panel is published on the websites of RRBs.</u>

Candidates can also view their shortlisting status for DV through the link available on the websites of RRBs.

- 2.0 The Shortlisting of Candidates for DV has been done considering the following,
- 2.1 Priority for various posts furnished by the candidates in the online application
- 2.2 Securing the qualifying mark of 35% in Part B.
- 2.3 For ALP Posts : Total of 70% of 2nd stage CBT Part A score & 30% of Aptitude Test T-Score are considered and
- 2.4 For Technician posts: Only 2^{nd} stage CBT Part A score is considered
- 3.0 Document Verification(DV) will be held at the place, indicated in the e-call letter for DV. After scheduling the candidates for DV, they will be sent an email and SMS to download their E-Call letter with details of date and reporting time along with the instructions for Document verification and Medical Examination.
- 4.0 Candidates may note that after completion of DV, they will be sent for <u>Medical Examination</u> at the nominated Railway hospitals located in the jurisdiction of RRBs. <u>This will also involve travel from RRB to the city of Railway Hospital.</u> Accordingly, Candidates have to come prepared for DV and Medical examination.
- 5.0 The shortlisted candidates for DV should produce all the original documents along with two sets of Xerox copies in A4 size as detailed in the CEN and e-call letter.
- 6.0 Candidature of all the shortlisted candidates for Document verification is purely provisional and is liable to be cancelled, at any stage of recruitment or thereafter, in case of any inconsistency/deficiency in the data furnished by them in their online application or any malpractice on the part of candidates coming to the notice of RRB at any stage of the recruitment process. It may be noted that merely calling a candidate for Document Verification does not entitle him/her in any way to an appointment in the Railways.
- 7.0 While every care has been taken in preparing the list of candidates shortlisted for Document Verification, RRB reserves the right to rectify any inadvertent error or typographical/printing mistakes. RRB regrets inability to entertain any correspondence from unsuccessful candidates.
- 8.0 **Important**: Beware of the touts who may misguide the candidates with false promises of getting them selected for the job on illegal consideration. The recruitment process in the RRB exams is fully computerised and the selection is based purely on the merit of candidates.
- 9.0 Candidates are advised to regularly visit RRB's official website for the updates.
